ENCOURAGING WORDS

Jesus <u>Is</u> The Reason!

We have begun the time of year that the slogan "Jesus is the reason for the season" emerges again from an eleven month slumber. While there is zero evidence (Biblically or historically) that Jesus was born on December 25, it does bring a certain satisfaction to hear folks suggest that "Jesus is the reason for the season." I say this because I do find some joy in knowing that people believe that Jesus is the reason for anything good these days! But, let's take a look at this slogan from a Biblical perspective. **Jesus is the reason for redemption.** You and I would be utterly damned in our sins if it were not for "the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish" that has "redeemed us to God." (1 Pet. 1:18-19; Rev. 5:9). Give praise to Jesus! **He is** the reason!

Jesus is the reason for hope. You and I would be eternally doomed if it were not for Jesus Christ! We possess "a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead" (1 Pet. 1:3). And because of Jesus," we have hope "as an anchor of the soul" (Heb. 6:19-20). Give praise to Jesus! He is the reason!
