### LADIES BIBLE CLASS RESUMES TUESDAY


Ladies Bible Class will resume this Tuesday @ 10-11:15AM. Come and enjoy a time of study and fellowship with your Christian sisters.

# **ENCOURAGING WORDS**

#### Your Person of the Year!

Here it is....2020 is now upon us! With it comes all the countdowns and end of the year reflections. One year-end tradition is Time Magazine's Person of the Year. You may have recognized the many notable people have been on the cover of the magazine. From Mahatma Gandhi (1930) and Winston Churchill (1940) to Adolf Hitler (1938) and Joseph Stalin (1940, 1942), Presidents, scientists, Nobel Peace Prize winners, and groups of people like the American Fighting Man (1950) and You (2006). These folks have helped shape the future of the world, some positively, some negatively. This gives us pause to consider the question....who has influenced our lives this year?

Think about all the people you encountered in 2019. Of those encounters, how many were significant? It could be that someone said something that stuck with you. It may have been positive or negative, but it might have caused a change in your life. It could also be that something has influenced your life as the result of an unexpected change in the life of someone close to you. When we look back, we can see that our lives are heavily influenced by those around us. If that's the case, then who are we keeping "around us"?

What about those that will move us "to love and good deeds" (Heb. 10:24). The immediate context of that verse is the general assembly of the church (Heb. 10:25). If we looked back on 2019, what percentage of Sundays were we in worship with the saints? How many times did I fellowship with my brothers and sisters outside the building? Would that have made a difference in our lives? There are many things that are out of our control. There are people that unknowingly influence us throughout the year, and we can't change that. We can control who we spend time with. We can choose to be around people that are going to help us on our Christian walk (John 13:34; Rom. 12:10; Gal. 6:2). Let's look back on our year and see who our person of the year has been. Christ will always be our greatest influence, but others can help (1 Cor. 11:1).
