"Our Teacher's Example"

We think of Jesus teaching large multitudes and He certainly did, but have you thought His work also involved one-on-one conversations with individuals? Look at this list.

He had individual, personal conversations with...

- The Samaritan woman;
- The woman taken in the act of adultery;
- Mary outside of her house after Lazarus died;
- Martha outside of her house after Lazarus died;
- Matthew as he collected taxes;
- The one thankful leper;
- The blind man beside the road in Jericho;
- Legion, the "wild man.";
- The thief on the cross;
- Zacchaeus in the tree; and many others.

Jesus came to seek and save the lost, but many times He sought them out individually.

How often have we failed to see that, while the Great Commission involves going into all the world, it is most often achieved by taking it to every creature? There is a different emphasis in "all the world" and "every creature." The commission in our lives always involves personal, individual contact!

Look at that list again, and see how often the contact with others was not a planned contact. Jesus walked on this earth, and as He walked He saw the people around Him. Do we notice the people around us? Not their physical presence but a far more important question. Do we see the souls of those around us? We see their bodies, but do we see their souls? Jesus did and so should we!
