

My Priorities!

If God were to ask "What is most important in your life," what would your answer be? Now before you answer, remember that God already knows the real answer before you give it! Will the answer that you give match the "actual" answer? The answer that God is looking for is not the one that would come from your lips and sound good, but the one that comes from your life. To find the answer to what is most important in your life, God would look at how you spend your **time.** That would tip Him off right away. We have more control over our time than we might accept or admit. Just by looking at how you use your time, God would be able to tell right away what is most important to you. Would it be Him? Would it be His cause on this earth? Redeem your time and use it for God! **Eph. 5:16** To find the answer to what is most important in your life, God would look at how you spend your money. He would know right away. Again, we have more control over our money than we might accept or admit. Look at every dollar you earn, have and spend. By looking at your bank account and your receipts, God would be able to tell right away what is most important to you. Would it be Him? Would it be His cause on this earth? Take control of your money and use it for God. Prov. 3:9

To find the answer to what is most important in your life, God would look at what you spend your time thinking about. Our thoughts are not unknown to God, but they are fully within our control. By looking at what you think about, what you want and what occupies your heart, God would be able to tell right away what is most important to you. Would it be Him? Would it be His cause on this earth? Take control of your thoughts and focus them on God and His will.
