The Bottom Line

As we make decisions, we all want to know what is on the bottom line. There may be several paragraphs with details, but we all want to get to the end because the bottom line clearly states the vital facts. It is so important that we examine the closing paragraphs of truth to see "the bottom line" of Christianity.

There is an Almighty God. If this is not true, then there is no bottom line of Christianity. If there is no God, there is nothing beyond the grave, for there was nothing before birth.

The Almighty God, the Creator, has revealed Himself. Even if He existed, there is nothing about His existence that impacts our lives unless He has revealed Himself.

The Almighty God has revealed Himself in a way we can understand Him. Unless He has revealed Himself to common people like us, there is no way to respond to Him, for there is no way we can know about Him.
