We have an opportunity to let our light shine in this election year by saying and posting both positive and encouraging remarks on social media, and not belittling those who disagree with us. We can always disagree without being disagreeable!

Watch Our Speech! Even in an election year, we are not exempt from **Ephesians 4:29** – *Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.*

Be In Subjection! Paul had reason to be concerned about the political climate of his day and wrote in **Romans 13:1** – Let everyone be subject to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God.

Jesus Has Been Given Authority! (Matt. 28:18). He is head over all things (Eph. 1:20-22; 1 Pet. 3:22). He is King of kings and Lord of lords (1 Tim. 6:15). He is ruler over the kings of the earth (Rev. 1:5).

The question now becomes, do we trust God and His sovereignty? No matter who wins on Election Day, will you be able to stand with confidence and say in your heart, "I trust God and know that He is in control"? If we can't do that without reservation, then we have lost perspective. Remember, it's not a matter of who occupies the White House, but who occupies OUR house!
