### **ENCOURAGING WORDS**

#### Are We Distracted?

It feels like there are so many things clamoring for our attention. Things like demands from work, the family schedule, end of the year preparations and seasonal shopping. On top of all that the media outlets are cascading with headlines about the election, fraud, spies, Corona, masks, infringement of rights, political unrest, persecution in Nigeria, and on and on it goes! It is no wonder that anxiety is the most common mental disorder in the United States and affects some 40 million Americans. That's 18% of the population! Even before the onset of Covid-19 and all the fear and regulations that came with it, these statistics were on the rise. So, what do we do with the distractions that lead us into distress and distrust?

We need to lift our heads and see beyond the cloud of competing information and the sources that demand our attention and go to the Scriptures to help us keep our perspective. One such passage is found in the book of Colossians 3:1-4 – "Therefore if you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth. For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory."

So here is a reminder that our thinking can get high jacked by the cares of this life. We need to set the dial of our mind, so to speak, programed to focused on heavenly things. This life with its cares and concerns is not the end ant it's certainly not heaven, but it can be heavenly if we allow our minds and hearts to be focused on Jesus. **Phil. 4:6-7** – Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
