ENCOURAGING WORDS

So What Now?

Is it possible that we have lost focus in the midst of all the political turmoil seen in the last election? Can you recall a time when so many people felt so strongly about the choice of a new president and the direction each of them would take our nation? Social media has reflected the division in a land envisioned as being "one nation under God, indivisible..."

Is it possible that we have forgotten that "our citizenship is in heaven" (Phil. 3:20)? Those Old Testament saints understood this. Abraham left the luxury of an easy life in the city of Ur, and he and his family spent the rest of their lives in tents. By faith they saw the promises of God were in the future and "...welcomed them admitting that they were foreigners and strangers on earth."

(<u>Heb. 11:13</u>) "Instead, they were longing for a better country—a heavenly one. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for he has prepared a city for them." (<u>Heb. 11:16</u>) Is it possible that we have lost sight of this fundamental truth and that God is ashamed to be called our God? We must never forget our true citizenship.

So, what do we need to do about all that is happening? Hear the words of Paul again about that which is first of all in these matters. "I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority." Remember who the king was Paul had in mind—it was Nero Caesar! What should we pray about? "...that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior." (1 Tim. 2:1-2)

It makes no difference who won the election, we must pray for those in Washington—of both parties.
