

### **ENCOURAGING WORDS**

### Having Rules is a Sign of Love

There has long been a discussion regarding the Bible as to whether it is "A Rule Book" or "A Love Letter." Some have argued over the years that the Bible is "A Love Letter" from God and should never be viewed as "A Rule Book." The question we need to consider is—What does the Bible teach? Are "love" and "rules" mutually exclusive?!

**First**, the Bible teaches with absolute clarity that God loves us (**John 3:16** etc.) That thought, in and of itself, just boggles the mind. We are so unlovable, and yet His love for us is unconditional. Yet, unconditional love does not mean unconditional approval.

**Second**, the Bible teaches that God wants all to be saved (<u>1 Tim. 2:4</u>) but His salvation is conditional (<u>Matt. 7:21-28</u>). God loves all mankind, but not all of mankind will be saved (7:13-14).

**Third**, the Bible teaches that obedience to the commands of God is absolutely essential in order to be saved (Heb. 5:8-9),

Fourth, the Bible teaches that there are commands given by God in the Bible and that God does "require" that we "keep the commandments" (<u>Deut. 10:12-13</u>), but what He commands is "for your good" (10:13) "always" (6:24).

Put all of this together. God loves us! God loves us so much that He wants to save us and has laid out detailed steps for us to take to be saved! God loves us so much that He warned us what would happen if we chose to not respond obediently to Him extending His love to us! He loves us so much that He gave us "commands" so that when we "keep" them, we demonstrate our "love" back to Him (John 14:15). Wow! What a loving, wonderful God we have!
