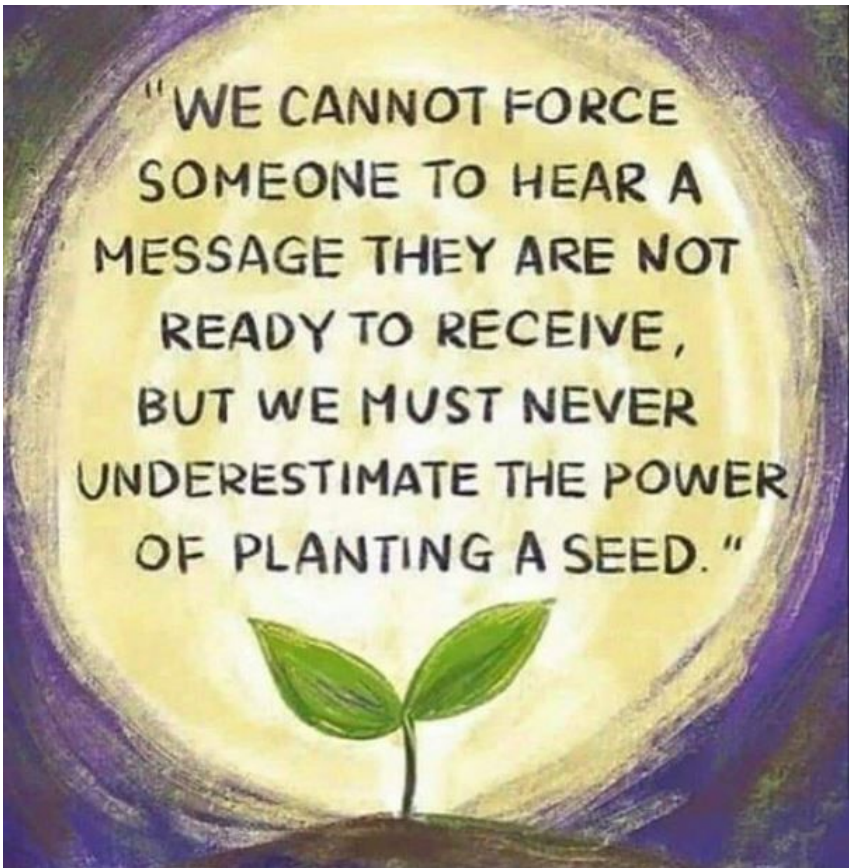

ENCOURAGING WORDS

Why the Wait?

That there will be final appearance before God and a final judgment is obviously taught in the Bible. It is not that in some vague way, open to various interpretations, that somehow men might be brought into His presence. The Scriptures are filled with clear statements which leave no doubt about that final judgment.

Listen to the finality of these words from heaven. "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ." **(2 Cor 5:10)** "For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ." **(Rom. 14:10)** "He has appointed a day on which He will judge the world in righteousness." **(Acts 17:31)** It is an eternal truth that it will happen.

In view of how sick and spiritually depraved our world has become, why has He not already come? There were those in the first century who thought He should have come and concluded that the Lord had made a promise to return and failed to keep it.

Why has God delayed? Read God's words about this question, and you will have a better understanding. "The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance."

(2 Pet. 3:9)
