

ENCOURAGING WORDS

Our Work as Christ's Church

The Lord's church was planned before the world was ever created (Eph. 3:10-11) and then Christ came and purchased and established His church in the first century (Acts 20:28). Man certainly has a lot of ideas about the church—what it is, what its purpose is, what its work should be, etc. In many instances, churches have become major businesses or even country clubs or entertainment venues. What does the Bible say is the work of the Lord's church?

First and foremost, the work of the church is to evangelize the lost world. The church has no greater purpose than this. This was the work that Jesus focused on during His lifetime (**Luke 19:10**; **Matt. 20:28**), and it is the work that He gave to His follows to do.. While this work can be done collectively as a congregation, each member of each congregation is individually responsible for taking the saving power of the gospel to the lost souls around them!

Second, the work of the church is to edify members of the church. The church must also look within, to build up those who are members of the church.

(1 Thess. 4:18; 5:11) There are those who are weak, struggling, dealing with loss, young in the faith, etc. Of course, every member needs to be encouraged whether they fit in a certain category or not. Again, a congregation can edify collectively through events, but it is also an individual Christian's responsibility.

Third, the work of the church is to extend benevolence to those in need. While there is a responsibility to "remember the poor" (Gal. 2:10) and to "do good to all" (6:10), God gives attention "especially to those who are of the household of faith" (6:10) and to widows and orphans. Obviously, the church cannot help everyone with every financial problem but must use prudence and wisdom in helping others. As with every work of the congregation, each member has an individual responsibility in this as well. (Eph. 4:28)

The Lord established His church and gave clear work for her to do. Let us busy ourselves in these areas of His work!
