Matt. 12:43-45

Introduction

Jesus took the time to address the spiritual condition of some first century Jews (Matt. 12:38-45). Jesus used an example of a man who had an unclean spirit to describe the need to fill the heart of man (Matt. 12:43-45).

III. We must get rid of the evil in our hearts, but we must also replace it with good.

A. How do we fill the heart with good?

I. There is great danger when our hearts are empty.

A. The heart can harbor both good and bad (Matt. 12:35; 15:19).

B. Like a home, the heart can be cleansed (Heb. 10:22; 9:14; Acts 15:8-9).

C. "Nature abhors a vacuum"-empty/unfilled spaces are unnatural.

1. If the heart is not filled with goodness, then the evil will likely return.

2. The condition will be worse than before (2 Pet. 2:20-22).

3. Consider the Corinthians (1 Cor. 6:11; 2 Cor. 12:20-21).

D. Our hearts can become hardened (Heb. 3:12-13; cf. 10:26-29).

II. How do we fill the heart with good?

A. Set first in your mind that God is the ruler of my life (1 Pet. 3:15; Rom 12:1-2)

B. Be careful about what you put into your mind (Col. 3:1-2; Phil 4:8)

C. Engage in good works (Eph. 2:20;

1 Pet. 2:1-2; Psa. 1:1-6; Matt. 5:16).

D. Choose our friends carefully (1 Cor. 15:33; Prov. 13:20).

Knowing Our Savior

A commonly used phrase in the religious world is, "Do you know the Lord as your personal Savior?" Have you been asked that question? The notion of knowing the Lord is certainly Biblical, but phrases and concepts are sometimes redefined to describe a concept not found in the Bible. For example, the word "baptism" has spread around the world to describe the sprinkling of water on an infant, but this concept is never found in the Bible!

There is that which the Bible says we can absolutely know. There is no room for doubt because the Bible speaks it clearly and precisely! Let's look at one of the many examples to be found in God's Word.

We Know That We Know Him

"Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments."

(1 John 2:3) Look at these words carefully. Not only is it possible for us to know the Lord, but we can also know that we know Him. The concept of knowing Him is not some vague, immeasurable idea. There is an absolutely certain way to check if we know Him. How do we know that we know Him? The Bible gives the evidence. It is not by some "born again" prayer that we remember people saying. It is not by some deep-seated feeling we have within us. Simply look at your response to what He has commanded, and if you are obeying them then you know Him and you can therefore know that you know.

We Can Know Far More Than We Realize

The phrase "we know" is found more than fifty times in the Bible and the apostle John uses it twenty-eight of those times. Aren't you glad that we can know Him? Aren't you glad that because of the Bible, you can know that you know Him?!
