

ENCOURAGING WORDS

He Lives!

Our family looked forward to the tree, the gifts, and the lights. Mom and Dad loved God, served Him with all their hearts, and taught us in word and by their example to live the same kind of life. We visited "Santy Claus" at the Sears and Roebuck store in Glendale, but we never talked about a tiny baby in a manger or travelers from afar. We believed that Jesus was not born on December 25th and that Christmas began as a pagan holiday that had no real connection with Christ. How could you take Christ out of Christmas when He was never in it to begin with?!

Norman Rockwell, the artist who was able to put reality on canvas, painted many Christmas covers during his long life. In 1956 his cover depicted a boy about 5 years old standing in front of his father's dresser. He had been looking for something in the bottom drawer and found a Santa suit and beard. He had learned a part of the truth about Christmas. He had learned that (don't read this to your children or grandchildren), there really is no such thing as Santa Claus. Rockwell treated Christmas just like my family, in a sweet but very secular way.

Santa Claus is not real. He doesn't spend one night a year traveling around the world giving gifts to all the children of the world, and the rest of the year in preparation for next year. Norman Rockwell got this one right!

Here is the real story. There really was a child born. He is the Son of God. He came to this earth to die a cruel, painful death. During His lifetime, many benefited from His miraculous powers and His powerful teaching. He came to establish a kingdom that would never fade away and to give His disciples the ability to live forever with Him.

For generations, through the influence of His enemy, many have said that He was a fraud, that there was no such thing as Jesus the Christ. You won't find evidence of that in someone's bottom dresser drawer. Though He was murdered for our sins, He lives!
