Looking Ahead 2022

Life is very short, our earthly futures all unknown. None of us know what will happen tomorrow, or even if we will be here to see it. None of us can know for sure what tomorrow may bring in reference to political issues, cultural issues, or personal health, safety, family, and/or financial issues; anything and everything from national disasters to natural dilemmas; and even when it comes to such life and death issues as the passing of loved ones or even our own, personal demise – we just simply cannot, and do not, know.

So, what do you know about the Future?

James 4:13-14 states this truth very clearly: *"Come now, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year there, buy and sell, and make a profit'; whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away."*

The brevity, concerns, and definite uncertainties of this earthly life – all of tomorrow's inestimable unknowns can make for a very scary, fragile, vulnerable, and joyless existence today. But it doesn't have to be that way! That is definitely not how God wants or intends for us to live. To that end He *"has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him."*
