ENCOURAGING WORDS

God and the "Numbers"

We live in a very analytical society that is concerned with the constant association of numbers and success. Businesses mull over sales quotas and production numbers like cows chewing their cud. Sports teams draft/play athletics based upon their "numbers." When our elected officials talk about the budget, we want to know the numbers. Even in matters of opinion we want to know what the polls say. A few years ago, there was even a television show now called "NUMB3RS" in which a mathematician uses equations to solve crimes. Our general philosophy seems to be, "If the numbers are up, life is good. If the numbers are down, then something's got to change!"

In a recent article in the "Christian Chronicle," it was stated that the churches of Christ have failed to keep pace with the population growth in the United States. I'm sure that there will be some who will be alarmed. But why should we be? God doesn't play by the numbers. With Gideon he took a mere 300 men and destroyed an army of thousands. God populated the world by just two people and then repopulated it again with eight. What about Noah's record? He failed to keep pace with the population gain of the entire world not just for a few short years, but for 100! Yet, when all was said and done, he and his family WERE the population!

The article also asked the question "Why?" Some speculated but offered no real answers. No doubt part of the answer is that we've begun to trust in numbers instead of trusting in God. God doesn't need our numbers to accomplish His will; God doesn't need us to keep up with the population growth; God doesn't need us to understand why we haven't. Regardless of what the numbers say, our job is to put our faith in God because after all is said and done, we are to plant and water, but it is God that gives the increase. (1 Corinthians 3:7)
