ENCOURAGING WORDS

Do What You Can Do!

Posted on the wall of a fitness center were the words of the great basketball coaching legend, John Wooden, who said, "Don't let what you cannot do interfere with what you can do." The implications are obvious when applied to physical fitness. Should I let the fact that I cannot walk on the treadmill for thirty minutes keep me from walking on it for twenty minutes? And, if I cannot do a certain exercise with 100 pounds of resistance, should I give up and refuse to try it at eighty? Of course not! Instead, I should do what I can do.

Similarly, in the spiritual realm, much good is left undone because we focus on what we cannot do rather than on what we can do. The pitiful tragedy of the one-talent man, described in Matthew 25, is the fact that he didn't do a thing with the money he had been given. He excused his inactivity by telling his master that the risks of faithful stewardship were too great (Mt. 25:24-25). At the very least, he should have deposited his master's money in the bank and drawn interest.

A life that pours itself out for others and is willing to take risks in order to please the Master must find its focus on what can be done. And what can be done in Christ are great things to the glory of God! Paul says, "*I can do all things through Him who strengthens me*" (Phil. 4:13). With God as our helper, let's work together for the betterment of His kingdom and the praise of His glory!
