**ENCOURAGING WORDS**

**Which is Easier?**

*Which is easier: to say to this paralyzed man, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up, take your mat and walk'? But I want you to know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins." So He said to the man, <sup>11</sup> "I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home." (Mark 2:9-11)*

Jesus spoke these words to those who doubted that He had the authority to forgive sins. The point of Jesus' words was to show by miracle that He had authority. There is a secondary lesson to consider here: Jesus' words were not like the words of many who say they will do something, but nothing happens. This reminds us of **1 John 3:18** - "Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth. It's easy to say, "I love you," to someone, but much harder to follow up because demonstrating love for another requires effort, commitment, and sacrifice.

In this sense, Christianity is not an "easy" religion. One must be a living sacrifice to have the kind of impact Christ wants us to have in the lives of others (**Romans 12:1**). It's not easy because we are required to sacrifice self that we may know Christ (**Philippians 3:7-11**). So, consider these...

- What is easier? - To say, "I am a Christian," or to go visit the person who is terminally ill?
- What is easier? - To say, "I love God," or to volunteer your time at an orphan's home taking care of children with no parents?
- What is easier? - To say, "Jesus is Lord," or to walk away from your friends who have invited you to go partying?

Jesus didn't choose the easy path, and neither should we. R. Senior
