Are We the Only Ones?

As we look around the religious world today, we see many differences in what various groups believe the Bible says or doesn't say. What is a command and what is simply a suggestion. We have popular religious leaders suggesting that, since we all believe in Jesus as the Son of God, that's all that matters and all these other issues that may separate our beliefs should be set aside, because, when it comes to salvation, they don't really matter! But they do matter!

And so, we take a stand! Sometimes that is difficult because we take that stand, not always against strangers or religious groups, but many times we take that stand against friends or even family members! And sometimes others go on the attack and won't let up on you, and sometimes, we just get tired of being the one who is being attacked.

And over time, some simply ask the question, why do I feel like we are the only ones who believe in this biblical truth?!
