ENCOURAGING WORDS

"There's a lot of that going around lately." An onslaught of runny noses, head congestion, sore throats, and even the flu is on a rampage this year as winter approaches. This time of year, our sick lists and prayer lists grow more and more in length. It is almost always met unanimously with the colloquial phrase, "Yeah... there's a lot of that going around lately." You'll hear this phrase in church foyers and doctors' offices everywhere. A phrase like this is not to diminish the individual's situation in the immediate context of the conversation. Instead, it's just an observation that many people are going through the same unfortunate circumstance.

The Lord's Church is no stranger to this phrase. There's a lot of **APATHY** going around lately when it comes to Christianity. Over the past few years, it seems like more and more Christians are growing apathetic when it comes to their faith. Instead of dedicating themselves to assembling with the rest of the Body of Christ, it has become easier and easier to stay home. Instead of having a willing spirit to serve and an active faith, it has become easier and easier just to let someone else do all that stuff. **Instead of asking what THEY can do for the Church, they ask what the CHURCH can do for them**. There's a lot of apathy going around lately, but at some point—it is time to SNAP OUT OF IT!

God's Word is clear regarding apathy and its place in a Christian's life. Paul told the Romans, "Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in the spirit, serve the Lord." Romans 12:11. Zeal is becoming harder and harder to come by these days. Instead of marching to Zion, many are just strolling along with a spirit of indifference. The fervor they once had has dissipated into apathy. Jesus makes it clear that there is no place for such Christians in the Kingdom of God, "So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth." Revelation 3:16. Apathy has no place in the Christian life!
