

- It tells all to live godly lives in whatever environment they find themselves.
- It seeks to change people through the power of the gospel.

When **churches**, **not individuals**, become involved in hospital and health clinic work, or when they build schools for the education of their children, or when they see as one of their great missions to provide for the world's poverty, or when they feel obligated to create social upheaval and campaign for human rights, or when they feel called upon to express their views on the government's use of nuclear armaments or whatever, they have a distorted view of the purpose of the church.
