

ENCOURAGING WORDS

No Shortcuts!

Shortcuts can be great. No matter what topic we're talking about, people are always looking for shortcuts, especially traveling through Los Angeles! Sometimes shortcuts can be found, while other times, only old-fashioned hard work will reach the goal. When it comes to spiritual things, people diligently and tirelessly search for shortcuts. Sadly, far too many have claimed to have found an "easy way into heaven." Even more tragic, every single time something like this is claimed, the truth of Scripture has been neglected.

Jesus made it unavoidably clear when He said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me"

(John 14:6). This is the only way. There are no shortcuts. There are no other paths. There are no other options. If we want to go to heaven and be with the Father, then we must go through Jesus by obeying His words found in Scripture (John 12:48).

There are plenty of shortcuts for everyday activities. There are no shortcuts into heaven. Perhaps this is why "the many" are on the wide and easy path towards destruction, and "the few" are on the narrow path leading to life (Matthew 7:13-14).
