I suppose this is relatively harmless, but Bhanu Prakash's mindset does seem to touch on a common problem in our world. Too often we replace the most important things with the things that are unimportant. We focus much of our time to become great at a hobby, or mindless hours fixed on TV while the important things are set aside. The very fact there is a world selfie record explains WHY we put lesser things first and first things last. We are a self-centered species interested in pursuing our own interests and pleasures.

On the eternal scale, compared to having a right relationship with God, so many things have essentially no importance. At one point in his life king Solomon began placing his focus on earthly things like riches, property, possessions, and power. He took the things that were unimportant and made them a priority. Every single time he found them to be meaningless and vanity. In fact, he uses this word "vanity" over 20 times in Ecclesiastes. After all his experimentation, he finally realized what was most important. "Now all has been heard; here is the conclusion of the matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is the duty of all mankind. For God will bring every deed into judgment, including every hidden thing, whether it is good or evil." (Ecc. 12:13-14).
