

ENCOURAGING WORDS

Not for Sale

Bob had just walked outside the front door to begin weeding the flowerbed when his neighbor saw him. The neighbor began the conversation with a comment about how sad he was to see Bob selling his home for they had become good friends. We are selling our *house*, Bob replied, not our *home*, and next month our *home* will be a new *house* just a few miles away. There is a vast difference in a home and a house, especially for Christians.

One aspect of that home is how marriage is viewed so differently. The vows made were not just words which seemed so appropriate for the occasion. They would never forget the expression found in that ceremony where they each promised "...to keep yourself him/her alone for as long as you both shall live," and, "For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh...Therefore what God has joined together let no man separate."

Their home had been built around these solemn promises that were made that day, and the trust which began that day was never violated. They have been faithful to each other. Divorce is not a word ever considered in their relationship!

There are many other aspects in the home of Christians which are not for sale, but one so vital is how children are seen. Like Hannah, they prayed before the children were born and God heard them. Hannah said, I prayed for this child, and the Lord has granted me what I asked of Him. ²⁸ So now I give him to the Lord. For his whole life he will be given over to the Lord." (1 Sam. 1:27-28)

Our world has vastly changed as the government uses the school system to control the values children need. If parents do nothing, children will be brainwashed by the new sexual orientation of society. Our children are **not** for sale! Our world view is different. Our homes are not for sale. We sell our houses but never sell our homes!
