## A Day of Remembrance

Tomorrow is *Memorial Day*, a national holiday. It is observed each year on the last Monday in the month of May. The holiday, formerly known as *Decoration Day*, commemorates military personnel, men, and women, who have died while in service to the United States of America.

The original purpose of *Memorial Day* was serious and probably evoked considerable reflection. It was common for people to visit grave sites of loved ones who had died in military service on that day. Today, *Memorial Day* seems to be more about having a day off work, going on a picnic with the family, and watching the *Indianapolis 500*. While those might be worthy endeavors, the real purpose of the day is what makes it special. Forgetting completely what *Memorial Day* is about leaves us more vulnerable to would-be enemies who would put us under their subjection.

Today is Sunday, the first day of the week, *the Lord's Day!* It is a *Memorial Day* that far surpasses in significance the holiday our nation will observe tomorrow.
