Thanks for Your Example

It is no accident, and certainly no mistake, that the Lord designed His church in such a way that males are to fill the leadership roles. Those who lead in worship are males (1 Tim. 2:8-15). Those who preach publicly are males (1 Cor. 14:26-40). Those who are appointed to leadership positions are males (1 Tim. 3:1-7, 8-13; Tit. 1:5-9).

However, it is no accident, and certainly no mistake, that the Lord designed His church in such a way that ladies can and should have a tremendously positive influential impact on the church.
