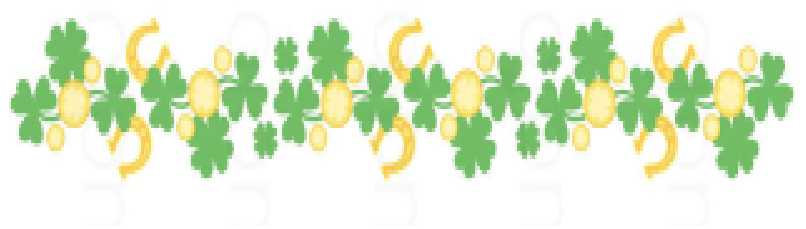

Our "Unchangeable God"

The God of the Bible, whose transcendent Word stood as a firm foundation, has been replaced by a god that is willing to bend his laws depending on the time, place and circumstance of each individual.

Many claim this "nonjudgmental, all-inclusive" god is the same Lord Jehovah we read of in the scriptures, however, he is a false idol created in the minds of men. Their god changes with every shift in the culture, ready to accept any sin man ties to his identity. But, the God of the Bible has never changed and is unchangeable. He is immutable. **(Mal. 3:6)**
