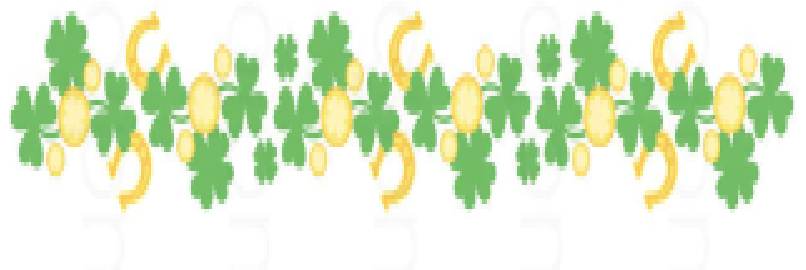

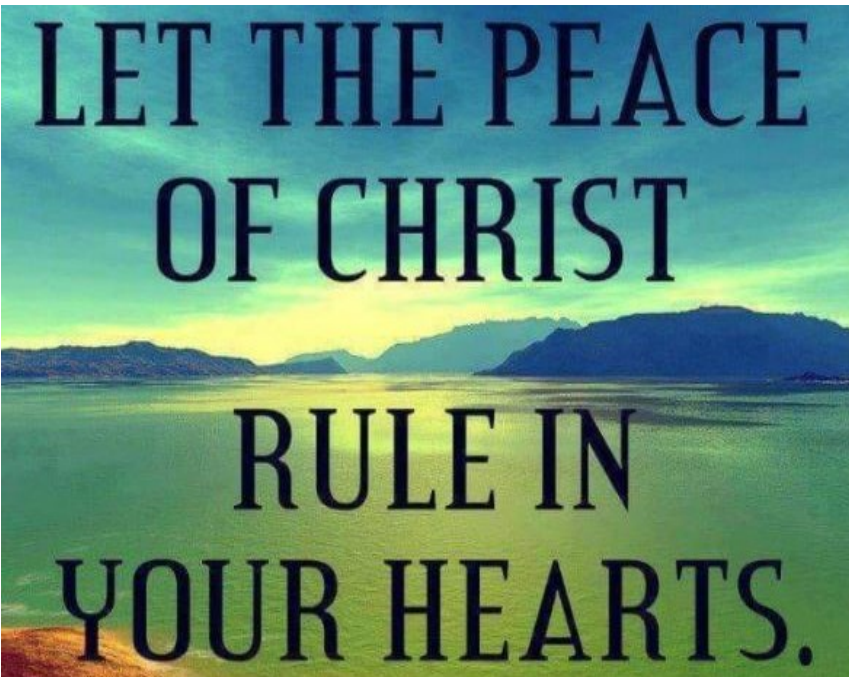

- No temple (Rev. 21:22). No sun, moon or lamp (Rev. 21:23; 22:5).
- No night (Rev. 21:25; 22:5). No defilement (Rev. 21:27) No curse (Rev. 22:3).
- No vile sinners (Rev. 22:15). No devil or evil temptations (Rev. 20:10).
- No end (Rev. 22:5; Matt. 25:46).
