ENCOURAGING WORDS

No Favorites!

One of the most amazing affirmations in the Bible — "God shows no partiality" (Acts 10:34). What a thought! This truth was not isolated to one time or one event in Scripture, but it is found throughout the Old and New Testaments. Paul not only affirms that "God shows personal favoritism to no man" (Gal. 2:6), but he reveals that it is against God's very nature— "There is no partiality with God." (Rom. 2:11)

God accepts all genders and all races equally. Are there any "other religions" or "other gods" who do that? Galatians 3:28 declares, "There is neither Jew nor Greek...there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus." "Whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him"! (Acts 10:35)

God accepts the "haves" and the "have-nots." Who does that? Who accepts both? In Christ, "there is neither... barbarian, Scythia, slave nor free, but Christ is all and in all" without partiality (Col. 3:11).

God accepts all sinners (Luke 5:32). He wants all sinners "to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth" (1 Tim. 2:4). "**Whoever** fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him" (Acts 10:35)!

God even accepts you and me! The fact that God shows no partiality, when we struggle so mightily with that weakness ourselves, is so amazing, so refreshing, so illustrative. Therefore, it should not surprise us that God calls upon us to follow His lead! "My brothers and sisters, believers in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ must not show favoritism." (Jas. 2:1)

We must not show personal favoritism to certain genders, certain races, certain "haves" (or "have-nots"), certain types of sinners, etc. Our responsibility is to take the gospel to ALL men and do good to ALL men, following the supreme example of our Savior!
